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Project Description

This **Maggies Centre** in Oldham will provide a program of support for anyone suffering with cancer across Greater Manchester.

The project architect is dRMM who were British Architects of the Year in 2013.

Key Facts

The centre is elevated on columns to provide a landscaped undercroft and using highly efficient, engineered timber in the form of laminated veneer lumber (LVL) floor and roof beams achieving span of 10m and cross laminated timber walls (CLT).

There is a glass-walled void running up through the centre of the building through which a tree will grow.
