Project Description

Highfield Humanities College was part of the Blackpool BSF programme and involved completely re-building the old college. The new building and facilities provides state of the art learning environments on a four-hectare site included a new school for 1200 pupils school and associated 6th form college, new sports pitches and tennis court.

The primary structural frame created by Booth King is an in-situ concrete flat slab utilising Post-Tensioned technology in order to achieve maximum operational flexibility and long-term adaptability.
