Project Description

This project is a care facility for acquired brain injury patients providing specialist care for vulnerable.

The design takes advantage of the existing levels of the site with a split-level design situated at the entrance to Liverpool at the end of the M62.

Key Facts

The design incorporated a storey height retaining wall, with the building being constructed mainly with traditional masonry and precast beam and block floor construction with some steelwork to create the open spaces
